

# Wibit Rules of the Road

These rules apply to all guests at your rental and all the pieces of the Wibit. Thank you for helping keep your party safe by following them.

- Obey the lifeguards at all times.
- All children ages 6 and under, regardless of swimming ability, must have an adult (15 or older) swim buddy in the pool within arms reach at all times.
- Please refrain from hanging on the ropes.
- Lifejackets are allowed on the structure. However, all guests using the structure must be able to pass the pool swim test without a lifejacket.
- Please remove necklaces, watches, rings, earrings and other sharp items before using the equipment.
- Please **DO NOT** swim under the structure.
- Entry onto the structure is allowed via the designated ramp or the climbing portion of the action tower. Entry area lifeguard will signal when it is safe to get on the structure.
- After exiting (or falling off) the structure please swim away from the structure. Please avoid any ropes or exit areas of the structure.
- Lifeguards have the authority to regulate traffic based on weight/usage.
- Feet first on your bottom on the slides please. DO NOT slide head first.

## **Action Tower XL (climbing tower) rules:**

- Entry to the tower is from the ramp or climbing wall.
- Guests that successfully make it up the climbing wall are asked to exit via the slide or platform.
- One person at a time on the climbing wall and people waiting should not wait directly beneath the wall.
- Feet first/bottom down when going down the slide. After sliding guests please exit the landing area
- Feet first only when jumping from the platform.

# Rules of the Pool

## TOP TEN RULES:

1. Lifeguards are in charge at all times.
2. Showers are mandatory.
3. Children 6 & under must have a swimming adult (15 or older) buddy within arms reach at all times.
4. Children & toddlers who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper with plastic pants over the diaper.
5. Non-swimmers & children in life-jackets must remain in designated shallow area.
6. Inflatable water wings are not allowed. Feel free to use one of our lifejackets.
7. Parents & rental guests are allowed on pool deck following deck policies. Street shoes are prohibited on pool deck. Clean deck shoes allowed.
8. Food, gum, drinks (water bottles ok) not allowed on pool deck.
9. Persons with communicable diseases, open sores, or wounds are prohibited in the pool.
10. Safe play enforced at all times. No stacking of toys is allowed.

## Diving Board:

- One person at a time on the diving board.
- Walk to the end of the board.
- One bounce only, please.
- Go off board only when the water below is clear of swimmers.
- Drive forward and straight out. No flips, spins or jumping to the wall.
- Cannonballs, jackknives and other splash making fun is encouraged.

## Water Slide:

- Must be able to swim and be 42-inches tall or taller. For rentals only: a parent can catch child as s/he exits the slide tube.
- Do not enter the slide tube until exit area is totally clear.
- Enter slide tube feet first on your back. No twisting or flippin in the tube.
- The slide area is a non-swimming area. **Slide exits only!**

## Ball Buoy:

- Swimmers only.
- Swing straight out & let go. Do NOT swing back toward the wall.
- After dropping off the buoy please swim away from the buoy and the diving board.

The District is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal items. (Lockers available for 25 cents. You are not sharing the pool so you are welcome to bring items out to pool deck for safety)
