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#### **Hole in the Wall Pool Kayaking Session**

"It may be cold drizzle outside but it's warm and sunny in the Anacortes pool. The pool is a great place to practice/learn skills and hang out with other members who are always willing to help."

This is how the local kayak club, Hole in the Wall, who regularly rents the Anacortes Pool to practice safety skills, announces its program. Members help members learn and become more confident in their kayaks. During the 1.5 hour pool sessions, members work on skills such as balancing/bracing, wet exits, rescues, re-entries and rolling. Practicing these skills in warm water builds the motor skills that members take out to the cold water of Puget Sound. Having access to the pool allows the club to promote safe and responsible kayaking for the entire community.

She learned to break down instruction into manageable parts so that children with varying abilities and motor skill levels could experience success. At FPFC, swim classes are integrated, so Jessica's ability to recognize individual needs and adapt classes to meet those needs will help all learning swimmers develop and improve their skills.

In her new role as Assistant Aquatics Director, Jessica will be working with swim classes, assisting Carla in day-to-day activities, managing scheduling, training staff, and working on special programs and events.
