

Lifeguard

Job Description

A lifeguard is responsible for ensuring the safety of patrons in the pool and providing life-saving rescues when necessary. Their duties include supervising swimmers, enforcing safety rules, and saving patrons in emergency situations.

Responsibilities

- Open and close the facility according to scheduled hours.
- Closely monitor activities related to the pool area, identifying safety issues throughout shift.
- Enforcing all safety rules for the pool.
- Regularly test pool chemicals and report any irregularities to appropriate management.
- Maintain a clean pool and locker room environment.

Qualifications

- Must be at least 15 years old.
- Current American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification or equivalent.
- Must be able to swim 300 meters of front crawl or breaststroke without stopping.
- Must be able to tread water for 2 minutes using only legs.
- Must be able to retrieve a 10lb brick from the bottom of the deep end (13ft) and swim back to the starting point within 1 minute and 40 seconds.
- Must be able to perform a deep water (13ft) spinal rescue.
